If this turns you on then the 2011 Peasant is the soundtrack to your life.

On The nose.... Spicy and velvet black cherry fruit laced with provencal herb and brought to life by a vibrant acidity that keeps this story alive and makes the fruit dance with long, graceful mouth feel..... I mean long. Dark brooding, cherry and berry fruit with a velvet mouth feel. The complex fruit laced with subtle tannins trail into a sexy finish of cedar, nutmeg, and caramel. This wine is why man domesticated Lamb....
